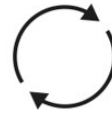

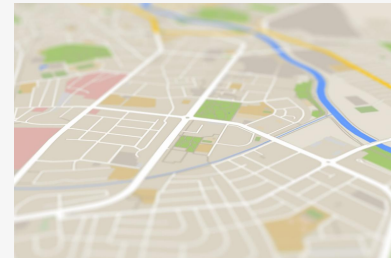

Business Briefs

The [Arizona Department of Transportation](#) advises drivers to plan for overnight lane restrictions on eastbound Interstate 10 near Casa Grande starting Wednesday, April 21. Work is scheduled to continue Sunday through

Thursday nights between 8 p.m. and 5 a.m. Eastbound I-10 will be reduced to a single lane each night for pavement repairs. Crews will work in approximately three mile segments between McCartney Road and Sunshine Boulevard.

In addition to lane restrictions, motorists should also expect a speed limit reduction to 55 mph within the work zone. Drivers should proceed with caution, slow down and watch for construction personnel and equipment. Schedules are subject to change based on weather and other unforeseen factors. SRP is Now Home to the Valley's Most Comprehensive Utility Technology Innovation Laboratory - New lab improves testing, training and efficiencies across power operations teams

Cross department collaboration, technician and engineer training, tabletop exercises and state-of-the art utility technology testing are just some of the value-added capabilities SRP has as part of its new Technology Innovation Laboratory in Scottsdale. Developments coming out of the lab will ultimately improve power reliability by focusing on technology that enhances aging infrastructure and results in fewer and shorter customer outages. SRP Celebrates the 25th Anniversary of the Modifications to Roosevelt Dam - This month marks the 25th anniversary of the raising of Roosevelt Dam, a \$430 million water infrastructure project that raised the height of the dam by 77 feet, more than doubling the lake's capacity and creating additional water supplies to serve more than 850,000 households per year.

As SRP celebrates the anniversary of the improvements made to Roosevelt Dam, the public power utility and water provider is also celebrating the partnerships with local and federal agencies that helped make this project a reality. SRP worked with the Bureau of Reclamation, the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, the Maricopa County Flood Control District and the cities of Mesa, Chandler, Tempe, Phoenix, Scottsdale and Glendale to fund and implement the modifications at Roosevelt Dam.
