Congratulations to our Business of the Week, [Casa Grande Trap & Skeet AZ, Inc.](#) The club has had a long history of providing league and competitive shooting for the locals, along with being the host of the Arizona Winter Chain events.

The Spring of 2007 brought new owners to the Casa Grande Trap & Skeet in Casa Grande, Arizona - the Volz Family, who had a long family history of shooting. The owner, Don Volz, grew up trap shooting with his Dad and brother. Today, that tradition of shooting and now running the Casa Grande Trap & Skeet carries on with the current three generations: Don, Doug, Bryce and Tanner Volz. The past few years, the Volz family has made much-needed improvements and renovations to Casa Grande Trap & Skeet. Since the improvements, scores are improving -- 100 and 200 straights are a regular occurrence and even Grand Slams have occurred.

The Volz family knows the future of trap and skeet shooting relies on younger generations enjoying the sport and understanding the operation of a gun club and have started an SCTP Team this year in an effort to encourage other youth shooters and families to enjoy the fun and pass on the tradition.

The club also continues to host the Arizona Winter Chain and fills their park with shooters who have been going to the club for 30 years. Casa Grande Trap & Skeet offers a pet friendly RV park, with handicapped accessible sites; all with full hook-ups, including water, sewer, electric and trash service. There's a full clubhouse with restrooms.
